

STONEBROOKE'S (Best Practices) during Covid-19 to offer a healthy, safe, "Outdoor Activity" during stay safer at home state orders

Guidelines that **MUST** be followed to offer a "touch free golf experience"

- Clubhouses and pro shops remain closed.
- No staff/customer interaction. All is done over the phone if needed.
- No currency exchange on property (payments made online or over the phone only to avoid physical contact).
- All practice facilities closed.
- Walking only (no motorized golf carts).
- No food or drink sold
- Flagsticks removed.
- Cups raised (to prevent ball from going in the hole and touching inside cup or liner).
- Removed objects on course that could be touched (ball washers, rakes, water coolers, benches, etc).
- Tee times spaced at least 10 minutes apart with a max of 4 people occupying each hole. Allows social distancing given average hole is 300+ yards.
- Sanitization methods (wipes, hand sanitizer, sanitizer fluids/towels) available.
- Place appropriate signage outside the pro shop and clubhouse outlining the social distancing guidelines in place per the Safer at Home guidelines:
 - a) Maintaining social distancing of six feet between people;
 - b) Washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds as frequently as possible or using hand sanitizer;
 - c) Covering coughs or sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow, not hands);
 - d) Regularly cleaning high-touch surfaces;
 - e) Not shaking hands; and
 - f) Following all other public health recommendations issues by DHS and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control
