

## 2021 Wednesday Night Cornhole League

**Dates-** February 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> DATES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

**Times:** Your matches will start at different times each week 5:00, 6:00, 6:30, 7:00, the schedule is posted online at [www.stonebrooke.com](http://www.stonebrooke.com), under leagues, Winter cornhole leagues.

**SUBS:-** If your original partner cannot play or both of you cannot play, you may have subs play in your spot.

**LATE ARRIVALS :** A team must have two players to start a game; no team shall start short.

A ten-minute grace period is allowed only for the first game.

**Teams:** 18 Teams -Round Robin matches so you will play each team once. Each Wednesday you will play 3 or 4 matches against different teams, 2 out of 3 games. You have 5 minute warm up in the beginning and a 25 minute time limit for the 3 matches. If teams are in the middle of a game when the 30 minute time limit expires, players shall finish their turn and the score will become official.

**Games # 1 and 2 will be played to 21 points**

**Game # 3 is a tiebreaker only game, and teams will play to 15**

### **RULES:**

1. Pick up your score card for each match. The first team on the scorecard will pick sides and bags and the second team on scorecard will throw first. The winner of the first match will throw first on the 2<sup>nd</sup> game. Teams will keep the same bags and sides for the remaining games.
2. Two players per team (doubles). Team partners face each other from opposite boards.
3. Distance measured between Foot Foul Edges: 22 feet
4. Opponents alternate tosses until all eight bags are thrown.
5. The round is then scored (See Scoring) the highest scoring team will then throw first.
6. Opponents may call Foot Foul and the call must be honored- the bag shall be removed from the board.

### **POINT SYSTEM & SCORING**

A game is won by the first team to score 21 points or more, the winning team does not need to win by 2 or more points, a score of 11-0 (SKUNK), or in the case of the match time limit expiring, whichever team is ahead, regardless of score.

- Points are scored when a player has a bag on the board or in the hole.
- Only one team can score per round.
- Points cancel each other.
- A bag on the board is equal to 1 point, a bag in the hole is equal to 3 points.
- An example of cancellation is as follows:
- Team one has 2 bags in the hole and 1 bag on the board equaling 7 points ( $3 + 3 + 1 = 7$ ).
- Team two has 1 bag in the hole and 1 bag on the board equaling 4 points ( $3 + 1 = 4$ ).
- The lowest score is subtracted from the highest score to get the points earned for team one ( $7 - 4 = 3$ ).
- Team one earns 3 points in this round and gets to throw first in the next round.

**PRIZES: All Prizes will be awarded as Stonebrooke gift cards and will be available after the final week of league.** You will play each team one time. Weekly prizes: Each win is awarded \$8 per win. End of Season Prizes: Will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place teams based on the number of wins. All ties will be split. Estimated Payouts (subject to change)

1st Place Team: \$220 per team

2<sup>nd</sup> Place Team: \$160 per team

3<sup>rd</sup> Place Team: \$130 per team

4<sup>th</sup> Place Team: \$100 per team

5<sup>th</sup> Place Team: \$70 per team

6<sup>th</sup> Place Team: \$40 per team
